General Requirements

- Knowledge of economic theory and a documented interest in theoretically based empirical work
- Very good methodological skills (data science, mathematics, statistics, econometrics)
- Experience with relevant software (e.g. R, Eviews, Stata, Matlab, LaTeX)
- Ability to work independently in a scientific manner
- Excellent English skills (written and spoken)
- Team communication skills
- Interest in or initial experience in modelling trade models is an advantage

The position is a project-funded part-time job with 30 hours per week, limited to 48 months from the start date. The salary corresponds to the FWF rate for doctoral candidates, currently €2,786.10 gross per month (for 30 hours per week, 14 times a year).
